

Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) Training

This training will support providers in improving their understanding and practice of the PSH model. Experienced and certified PSH trainers from the Technical Assistance Collaborative (TAC) have created the training. These sessions will be facilitated by TAC trained Partner's staff. This training is required for all members of a Community Support team within 90 days of hire. PSH is also recommended as a best practice for ACT Team members and providers who assist members with gaining and sustaining housing in the community.

When and Where:

- Sessions will run on Tuesday and Thursday mornings for two weeks to gain the full 15 hours (equal to a two day in-person class)
- Sessions are virtual, using a zoom platform
- Registration is limited! First Come/First Serve

Requirements for Training:

- Attendees must fully interact using both video and audio (A brief tutorial will be offered on the first day)
- Attendance at all four sessions is required to gain a training certificate
- If you miss more than 15 minutes of content, you will not receive credit
