Building a Bridge to Security

Having a place to live that meets your needs is vital to your health and well-being.

Vaya Health's **Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)** program can make that happen. PSH finds housing for people with a disability who are experiencing homelessness. PSH pays your rent and helps you stay in your home for good.

Vaya has PSH programs in Alexander, Caldwell, Clay, Cherokee, Graham, Haywood, Jackson, Madison, Macon, McDowell, and Swain counties.

How to get started:

1. Call 2-1-1 or Vaya's Housing team at 1-800-962-9003, ext. 4560.
2. Ask for a Coordinated Entry referral – this is the name of the process that matches you to the best housing option.

Staff will connect you to the resources you need.
